WHAT NOT TO BRING

- **Campers should NOT bring any of the following items:** cash, cell phones, electronic games, food, pets, fireworks, computers, DVD players, water guns, lighters, matches, tobacco products, drugs, drug paraphernalia, alcohol, or ANY weapons. If a camper brings any of the above items to camp, the item will be confiscated and either sent home or held until the end of the session. Campers found in possession of weapons, drugs, alcohol, or drug paraphernalia will immediately be dismissed from camp and the item(s) will not be returned. Please do not bring any valuable items to camp, as campers tend to forget, lose track of, or misplace things.
- **Your Own Food:** In order to prevent pests we do not allow campers to bring their own food. However, if your child has certain food allergies or conditions that would prohibit them from eating our meals, please call our office at 434-376-2006 to discuss your options with our Food Service Director.

DRESS CODE

Hat Creek Camp has determined a specific standard of dress for all attendees, including leaders in order to uphold our belief in honoring the Lord with our appearance. With all of us working together to uphold this standard, we hope to maintain a focus on what truly matters. This is an advanced notice so that you can pack accordingly. While our staff works hard to enforce our standard of dress, we try not to make it our only focus. We apologize in advance if there are any inconsistencies in addressing the standard of dress for one student and not another. We do rely on you and appreciate your efforts to maintain this standard of dress for the duration of camp.

General Dress

- No clothing revealing the stomach, back, or undergarments or excessively tight against (sagging shorts, bra straps covered, etc...)
- Shorts should be longer than fingertips when arms are down
- Clothing should not display any offensive language/message or drug/alcohol related graphics.
- Closed toed shoes when walking around camp

For the Lake

- **Boys:** Shirts must be worn to and from the lake, must wear swim trunks (athletic shorts are not swim trunks)
- **Girls:** Modest Bathing suit (one piece or full covering 2 piece)
